

1 Day **North Delhi**


Day 1: Arrival in New Delhi

Mathura


New Delhi to Mathura (3-hour drive)


Excursion to Govardhan Hill & Barsana

Vrindavan


Mathura to Vrindavan (30-minute drive)

- **Evening**: Attend the Aarti at Banke Bihari Temple.


Vrindavan Sightseeing

Agra

Vrindavan to Agra (1.5-hour drive)

- **Evening**: Enjoy the sunset view of the **Taj Mahal** from Mehtab Bagh, a picturesque garden across the Yamuna River.
- Overnight Stay: Agra.

East Delhi

Agra to Delhi – Departure



- **Early Morning**: Visit the **Taj Mahal** at sunrise for a truly magical experience. This stunning monument, built by Shah Jahan in memory of Mumtaz Mahal, is one of the most celebrated symbols of love.
- Return to hotel for breakfast.
- Transfer to New Delhi (3.5-hour drive) after checkout.
- **Departure**: Drop-off at Delhi Airport or railway station for your onward journey.
