

Oslo

Journey over the Mountains



After breakfast, make your way to **Oslo Central Station** and board the **Dovrebanen** train. This scenic route takes you across the **Dovre mountain plateau**, passing through historic towns and nature reserves. Upon arriving in **Dombås**, transfer to the **Raumabanen Railway**, often regarded as one of the most spectacular train lines in Norway. Prepare to be mesmerized by endless stunning views, including the dramatic **Kylling Bridge** and the powerful **Vermafossen** waterfalls below. The train will take you to **Åndalsnes**, where you will disembark and board a bus to continue your journey. Along the way, enjoy more breathtaking landscapes as you make your way to the lively port town of **Ålesund**. Spend the night in **Ålesund**.



Geiranger Fjord Cruise

Today, you'll embark on a scenic adventure through the majestic **Geirangerfjord**. This 3-hour boat tour, complete with an informative audio guide, takes you through three breathtaking fjords and their stunning landscapes. **Geirangerfjord**, a UNESCO World Heritage site, is known for its serene waters surrounded by towering mountains. Keep an eye out for awe-inspiring waterfalls, including the iconic **Seven Sisters** and **Bridal Veil**. The tour also includes a stop in the picturesque **Geiranger village**, an idyllic spot surrounded by lush landscapes and well-maintained walking trails. In the afternoon, the cruise will return you to **Ålesund**. Spend another night in **Ålesund**.



A Day in Beautiful Alesund & Coastal Cruise

Spend a leisurely day in Alesund, a charming fishing and ferry town steeped in history.

The town's architecture, featuring Art Nouveau turrets, spires, and intricate ornamentation, creates a fairytale-like atmosphere.

Key highlights include the **Ålesund Museum**, the **Atlantic Sea Park**, and the stunning viewpoint on **Mount Aksla**. To reach the viewpoint, follow the steps to an area known as **Kniven** ("the Knife").

After a relaxing evening in town, you'll board either a Hurtigruten or Havila Voyages overnight cruise bound for Bergen.

Spend the night aboard the coastal cruise. If you wish to enjoy a bit more relaxation before your cruise departs, you can request a late check-out from your hotel (additional cost applies).

Sail to Historic Bergen

Overnight, your cruise will stop at the towns of Torvik, Maløy, and Florø.

As morning arrives, **Bergen** will come into view. Disembark to explore this charming city, often called the "Capital of the Fjords." Despite being an international city, Bergen exudes the warmth and charm of a small town.

Make your way to **Bryggen**, a historic district featuring well-preserved old houses. This vibrant area is also home to a bustling fish and flower market, where local vendors offer fresh goods.

While in Bergen, be sure to visit the **Troldhaugen Museum**, dedicated to composer **Edvard Grieg**, and **KODE**, Scandinavia's largest museum of art and design. Spend the night in **Bergen**.

Start by taking a ride on the **Fløibanen Funicular** to the summit of **Mount Fløyen**, where you can enjoy breathtaking panoramic views of the city and its surroundings. For an even higher vantage point, take a cable car up to **Mount Ulriken**, where you can explore winding hiking trails that lead across the mountains, offering scenic vistas along the way. Back in the city, visit some of Bergen's renowned museums, including **Troldhaugen**, dedicated to the famous composer **Edvard Grieg**, and **KODE**, Scandinavia's largest museum of art and design. Alternatively, head to the harbor to join optional day cruises exploring the stunning fjords. Spend another night in **Bergen**.

Norway in a Nutshell by Land and Sea

Today marks one of the most scenic segments of your journey. Say farewell to **Bergen** and board the **Bergensbanen train**, traveling through majestic mountains to the town of **Voss**. From Voss, you'll continue to **GudvangenHarbour**, where you'll embark on a 2-hour **fjord cruise** to **Flåm**. The cruise will take you through **Nærøyfjord**, the narrowest fjord in all of Europe, a UNESCO World Heritage site that's part of the spectacular **Sognefjord**, Norway's longest and deepest fjord. Marvel at the towering peaks, cascading waterfalls, and picturesque farmhouses along the way. The boat will then navigate **Aurlandsfjord** before reaching **Flåm**, a charming village nestled at the edge of the fjord. Spend the night in **Flåm**. For added comfort, we suggest booking a **luggage transfer** for your journey between Bergen and Oslo.

Bergen

The Flåm Railway Experience

Spend the morning exploring **Flåm**, taking in the stunning natural surroundings and immersing yourself in the village's cultural highlights.

Visit the Flåm Railway Museum to discover the fascinating history behind this world-renowned train route, or head up to the Stegastein viewing platform for breathtaking views over Aurlandsfjord.

In the afternoon, embark on the iconic **Flåm Railway** journey. The train ascends 900 meters (2,952 feet) in just 20 kilometers (12 miles), offering spectacular views and photo opportunities along the way.

Upon reaching **Myrdal Station**, transfer to the **Bergensbanen train**. This scenic route takes you through the picturesque villages of **Geilo** and **Gol**, before arriving in **Oslo**. Spend the night in **Oslo**.



Departure from Oslo

Your adventure in Norway has come to an end! If your flight departs in the afternoon, take the opportunity to enjoy some final moments in **Oslo**. You could shop for souvenirs, visit one of the city's museums, or simply wander through the charming city center. When it's time to head to the airport, you can take a taxi.
