

ENJOY ENCHANTING OSLO

You could also visit the Fram Museum, which houses a polar exploration ship, or the Munch Museum, home to works by Edvard Munch.

NORWAY IN A NUTSHELL – THE FLÅM RAILWAY

Start early and head to Oslo Central Station to begin the Norway in a Nutshell® journey to Bergen, with an overnight stop in Flåm.

The journey takes you through picturesque mountainous landscapes, passing charming villages like Gol and Geilo.

At Myrdal, transfer to the famous Flåm Railway for a breathtaking ride to the village of Flåm.

NORWAY IN A NUTSHELL TO BERGEN

This morning, take a boat through Aurlandsfjord and the UNESCO-listed Nærøyfjord, Europe's narrowest fjord.

Marvel at majestic waterfalls and small farms nestled in steep mountainsides as the boat docks in Gudvangen. From there, travel by bus to Voss and take the train to Bergen.

THE CAPITAL OF THE FJORDS

Today, explore Bergen at your leisure. Start by riding the Fløibanen Funicular to the summit of Mount Fløyen for panoramic views.

You can continue to Mount Ulriken by cable car, where hiking trails connect seven surrounding mountains.

At ground level, visit museums like Troldhaugen, dedicated to composer Edvard Grieg, or KODE, Scandinavia's largest art and design museum.

Alternatively, take a day cruise from the harbor to explore the nearby fjords.

DEPARTURE FROM BERGEN

It's time to bid farewell to Norway. If your flight departs in the afternoon, you can spend a few final hours shopping or visiting a museum in Bergen.

When it's time to head to the airport, take a bus or taxi from the city centre, or arrange for a private transfer.

If you're flying from Oslo, we can book a direct train back to the capital. Note that an extra night's stay may be required if your flight is early in the morning.
