Gabala is a scenic mountain town in northern Azerbaijan, about 220 km from Baku (approx. 3.5-4 hours by car). It's popular for its natural beauty, historical sites, and family attractions.

Tufandag Mountain Resort

Skiing and snowboarding in winter

Cable car rides with stunning views all year

Mountain hikes and cafes at the top

Gabaland Amusement Park

Azerbaijan's largest amusement park

Great for families with kids

Nohur Lake (Lake Nohurgol)

A peaceful lake ideal for boating and picnicking

Surrounded by forested mountains

Yeddi Gozel Waterfall ("Seven Beauties")

A beautiful tiered waterfall in a forest area

Best viewed after rain or in spring

Chukhur Gabala and Ancient Ruins

Remains of the ancient capital of Caucasian Albania

Gabala Shooting Club

Offers paintball, shooting, and archery experiences

**Gobustan** (also spelled Qobustan) is a UNESCO World Heritage Site located about 65 km southwest of Baku, renowned for its ancient rock carvings, mud volcanoes, and archaeological significance. It offers a rare combination of prehistoric culture and geological wonders, making it a top day-trip destination from Baku.

#### Main Attractions

Gobustan Rock Art Cultural Landscape (Petroglyphs)

Features more than 6,000 rock engravings dating back over 40,000 years

Depict hunting scenes, ritual dances, animals, boats, and human figures

Offers insight into prehistoric human life and early settlements in the region

Gobustan Museum

Modern interactive museum near the archaeological site

Exhibits include 3D models, ancient tools, and a timeline of human history

Great introduction before visiting the actual rock carvings

#### Mud Volcanoes

Azerbaijan has the highest concentration of mud volcanoes in the world (over 350)

The ones near Gobustan are particularly famous for their bubbling, lunar-like landscape

The mud is cool and non-toxic—some visitors touch it or take photos near eruptions

Gaval Dash ("Tambourine Stone")

A large flat stone that emits musical, drum-like sounds when tapped

Believed to have been used in rituals or music-making by ancient inhabitants

### Absheron Peninsula, Azerbaijan

The Absheron Peninsula is where Baku is located and extends into the Caspian Sea. It's known for its natural gas phenomena, ancient temples, beaches, and oil history. A great day-trip destination from Baku.

#### Top Attractions

Ateshgah (Fire Temple of Baku)

Located in Surakhani

A 17th-century fire-worship temple built on a natural gas field

Significant to Zoroastrian and Hindu travelers

Yanar Dag ("Burning Mountain")

A hill that has been burning with natural gas for decades

A fascinating natural fire phenomenon

Qala Archaeological and Ethnographic Museum Complex

Open-air museum showcasing ancient settlements, caravanserais, and petroglyphs

Great for families and culture lovers

Absheron Beaches

Best in summer; popular beaches include Bilgah, Amburan, and Shikhov

Offer swimming, water sports, and beach clubs

Masazir Salt Lake

A pink-hued salt lake similar to ones found in Australia or Turkey
