Gobustan (also spelled Qobustan) is a UNESCO World Heritage Site located about 65 km southwest of Baku, renowned for its ancient rock carvings, mud volcanoes, and archaeological significance. It offers a rare combination of prehistoric culture and geological wonders, making it a top day-trip destination from Baku.

Gobustan Rock Art Cultural Landscape (Petroglyphs)

Modern interactive museum near the archaeological site
